

At Dean Close School the course currently offers the following:

Paper 1: Breadth study: the study of a 100 year period of significant historical development. Topics: Either The Age of the Crusades, c1071–1204 OR The Quest for Political Stability: Germany, 1871–1991

40%

Written examination 2 hrs 30 minutes, includes both essays and an evaluation of the interpretations of three historians.

Paper 2: Depth study: the study in depth of a period of major historical change or development. Topics: Either Religious Conflict and the Church in England, c1529 –c1570 OR The Making of Modern Britain, 1951–2007

40%

Written examination 2hrs 30 minutes, includes both essay and evaluation of primary sources .

Component 3: Coursework

20%

This is a an independent research study based on a topic of student's choice. 3000-3500 words. Recent topics have included the French Revolution, Russia under the Tsars and the Fall of the Roman Republic.
