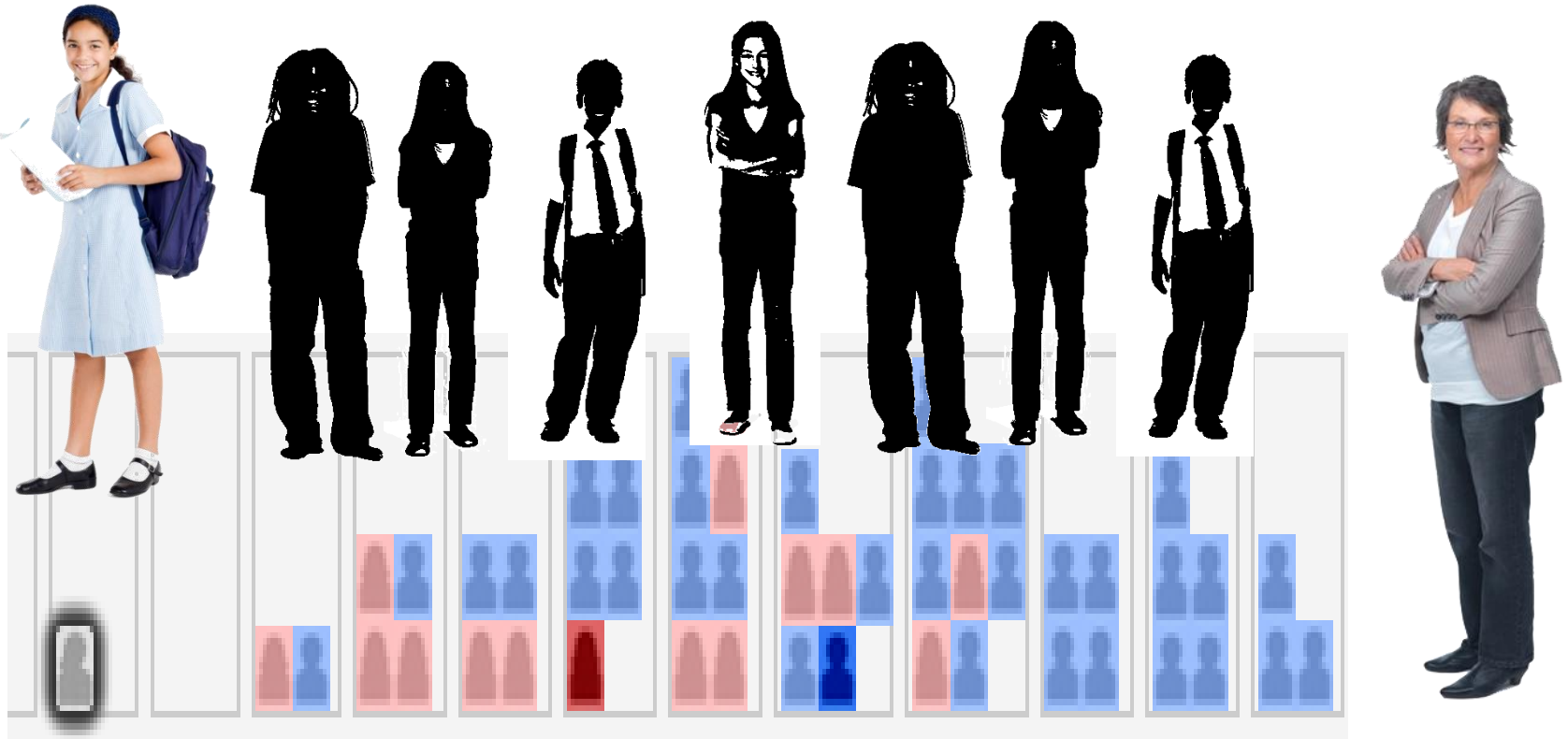




Dean Close Prep School is piloting As Tracking

With some robust science and 5 years of research and 15,000 trials with top schools

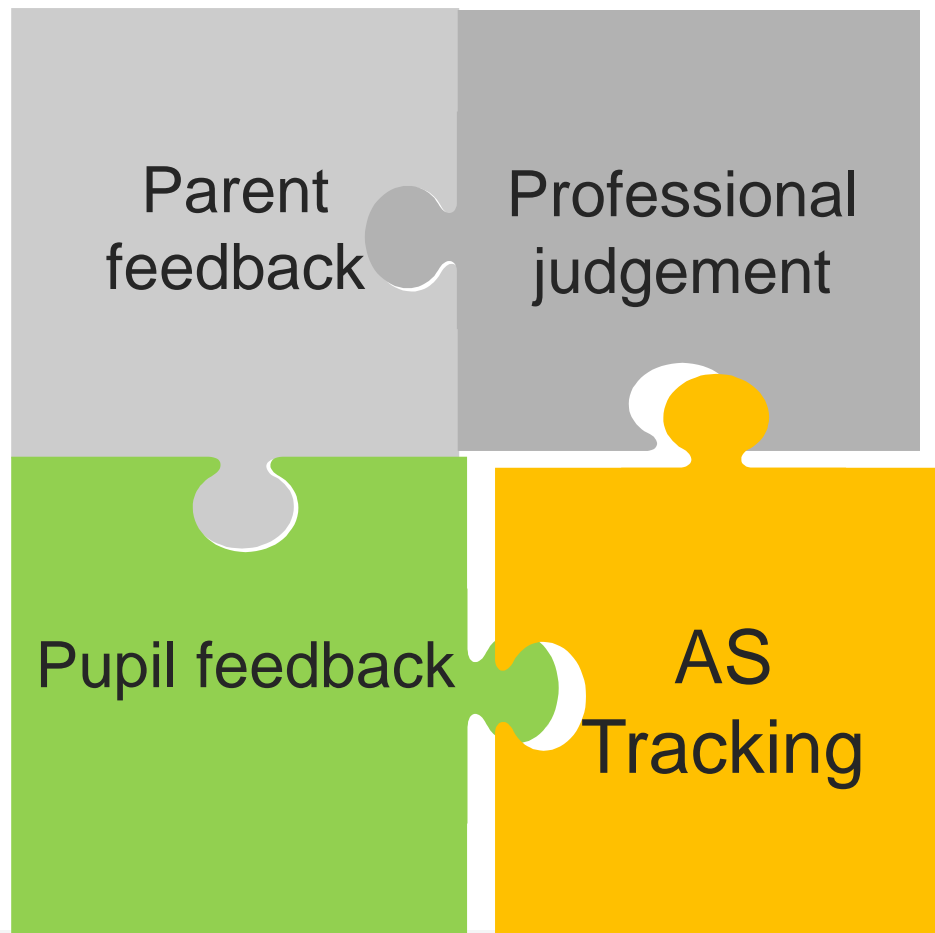
Your child will be tracked, along with all other pupils, twice each year through a secure, online assessment.



Your child's AS Tracking data will only be seen by their pastoral teachers, who have been trained to read the data.



It will form one piece of the jigsaw we use to understand and support your child



We may use the data to support a pupil with low-level, targeted in-school signposts
