As part of the Geography GCSE course, your son/daughter must have the opportunity to undertake fieldwork, both physical and human in order to gain information, knowledge and skills for their GCSE exams. In order to meet this requirement, a day's field trip has been organised to Bristol. This trip will provide the opportunity to collect primary data, which will be written up in school and assessed in paper 3 of your son/daughter's Geography GCSE exams. Bristol is our case study for a UK city that is experiencing urban issues and challenges and will enable the students to see areas we have studied first hand.
