Dear Parents/Guardians/Boarding House parents of pupils in Year 6,

On Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April, Year 6 will be going on a trip to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard. This links in with our History work on Admiral Lord Nelson. The children will have a tour of Admiral Nelson's ship, Victory and an opportunity to experience the Royal Navy Exhibition of Action Stations.

The children need to arrive at 7.50am as we need to have a prompt departure at 8.00am for the journey. Our estimated time of return is 6.45pm, but we will send a clarion call on our return journey at 5.30pm approximately with an accurate return time. Those children who usually have a music lesson on Tuesday will have their lesson reorganised by their music teacher.

Please make sure your child comes equipped with the following items, boarding house parents will arrange any specific requirements.

The children need:

- **School uniform**
- **a school coat** just in case it rains!
- **small rucksack** so that they can carry their packed lunch
- **a water bottle** with water in
- **no electronic items will be permitted**
- **£6.00 maximum pocket money** to be spent on worthwhile educational materials and postcards
- **anything else that they usually need**, such as inhalers for asthmatics

We will provide a packed lunch and snacks so please **do not** give your child extra food.

If your child has any allergies (especially to farm animals or grass) which the school do not already know about please do let us know.
