As a progressive school that always looks for improvements in academic and pastoral provision for pupils we are currently using a social-emotional assessment and tracking tool called 'AS Tracking' - the same tool is used at Dean Close Preparatory School and St.John's-on-the-Hill, and around 150 other schools in both the independent and state sector.

It features a short on-line questionnaire that generates useful insights into how pupils respond to the everyday challenges of school life in different ways and it is used by HsMs and tutors to support proactive, targeted and evidence-based pastoral care. It adds another piece of the pastoral jigsaw, helping us to build a more rounded picture of each scholar's social and emotional development. Please note that AS Tracking does not give pupils a report and the data is only used internally by pastoral leaders to guide them in supportive, individual pastoral care. Each year, scholars complete the assessment twice and their data creates a narrative of their adolescent social-emotional journey. There is no charge for the assessment and it will only be taken in 2019-20 by the 4th and Remove year groups.

For the first time this year, the preferred option will be for pupils to download an app, allowing them to take the assessment on a smartphone, but there will be an alternative option if that is not possible for any reason.
