These exciting activities are aimed at Year 8 to help parents and students choose their subjects at GCSE's. It gives students and their families an opportunity to see how studying Computer Science can help improve the understanding of technology in the workplace and in their homes. CyberFirst Trailblazers is a free half day event created for Year 8 students. The event is designed to showcase the varied opportunities that can be achieved through the understanding of how technology is used in the workplace.
