

Uniform for Sixth Form

Sixth Form pupils are expected to be well presented and have a business-like appearance whilst at school. Suits for girls and boys should be clean, pressed, well-fitting and worn as designed. All clothing must be clearly marked. Individuality is encouraged within the uniform guidelines.

School Blazer offer an online service for girls to order suits and blouses. Please visit www.schoolblazer.com and follow the links to set up an account. This will then give directions to the Dean Close page. Orders need to be placed early for September but delivery times are shorter at other times of the year.

The School Shop can advise on all uniform issues.

A tailored skirt or trouser suit in a dark colour x 2 - Faint pinstripes or checks are permissible. A shift dress is also allowed. All suit pieces must be made of the same fabric and be designed to be worn together. Stretch fabrics and body contour wear are not allowed. Skirt length should be no more than 10cm above the knee when seated. Trousers must be tailored and full length

Hair should be of natural colour, and of a moderate style

Best dress (not shown). Black skirt suit with white blouse. This is worn for Friday and Sunday Chapel services, Theatre events and other formal occasions

Plain black or dark, leather shoes with heels no higher than 5cm. These must be robust and suitable for school wear. Boots are not allowed



Discreet make-up and pale nail varnish only are allowed

Blouse with collar and sleeves x 4 - Plain colours, pinstripes and moderate checks are allowed. See-through fabrics and sleeveless designs are not permitted. All blouses must be tucked in and buttoned above the breast bone

Jumper or cardigan – plain single colour of knitted fabric. This should not be seen below the hem line of the jacket or beyond the jacket sleeve. Multiple layers are not permissible

Jewellery – must be discreet and removed for games

Coat (not shown). Dark and of mid thigh to mid calf length

Plain, dark coloured or neutral tights. Socks, patterned tights and bare legs are not permissible

Dark business-like suit - Faint pinstripes or checks are permissible. All suit pieces must be made of the same fabric and be designed to be worn together

Shirt with collar, long sleeves and cuffs x 4– light coloured plain, pinstripe or checks are allowed. Short sleeved shirts may be worn in summer

Plain black, polishable leather shoes, Boots are not allowed. These must be robust and suitable for school wear

Plain, dark coloured socks

Best Dress (not shown). Dark formal suit with white shirt. This is worn for Friday and Sunday Chapel Services, Theatre events and other formal occasions



Jumper or cardigan – plain single colour of knitted fabric and v-neck design. This should not be seen below the hem line of the jacket. Multiple layers are not permissible

Tie of own choice and design suitable for school

Hair should be of natural colour and of a moderate style. Dyed hair and extreme styles are not allowed

Boys must be clean shaven

Coat (not shown). Dark and of mid thigh to mid calf length

Optional items available from the School Shop include a school scarf and cufflinks
