






## **Dean Close COVID-19 Response October 2020 update**

If a pupil or member of staff displays possible Coronavirus symptoms in school the following steps are taken:




The following decision trees will be used to decide how to treat a day or boarding pupil:




## What happens if a pupil is asked to isolate?

### Day pupil

## What is a close contact?

If a person tests positive for Coronavirus, close contacts have to be traced and self-isolate for 14 days in case they have contracted the virus. A close contact is:

- **People in the same household (boarding bubble)**
- **Skin-to-skin physical contact**
- **Contact within one metre with or without a face mask for more than a minute**
- **Contact within two metres with or without a face mask for more than 15 minutes**
- **Travelled in a car together or in close proximity on other transport**

Close contacts must self-isolate for 14 days; Contacts of contacts don't need to unless they develop symptoms.
