The Director of Music may place musicians into different classes if more appropriate. Pupils who have not taken a grade exam recently should enter the class appropriate to their current standard, decided by their instrumental teacher.

- You will be sent the upload link for your class on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> March with instructions for recording.
- **Record your piece by Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> March**, using a backing track or live accompaniment in a lesson. If no accompanist or suitable backing track is available, you may play unaccompanied.
- **Sherratt Cup Competition:** We are intending to record all Sherratt performances on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> March with a live accompanist, regulations permitting. Everyone who intends to enter the Sherratt should email Mrs Klemz asap, please, with details of your piece so that we can arrange an accompanist and a recording slot. This will replace the usual audition.
- Winners will be announced on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> March and there may be a recorded concert of winners at some point in the Trinity Term.
- It is expected that all Music award-holders and those studying music at GCSE and A level will enter on at least one instrument.
- Your piece must not exceed the time limit for your class.
- No-one may enter more than twice in the Sherratt Class.
